1. _____: Angle at which the fingers are held when cutting, and, ultimately, the line that is cut
2. _____: Tool used when cutting thicker and longer lengths, where detailing is not required
3. _____: Inner or internal part
4. _____: Graduated shape or wedge; an effect or haircut that results from cutting the hair with tension, low to medium elevation, or over direction
5. _____: Section of hair, located either at the perimeter of the interior of the cut, that determines the length the hair will be cut
6. _____: Used mainly for removing length and detailing the haircut
7. _____: Angle or degree at which a subsection of hair is held, or lifted, from the head when cutting
8. _____: Amount of pressure applied when combing and holding a section, created by stretching or pulling the section

9. _____: Rolling your shoulders back and standing directly (parallel) in front of the section on which you are working
10. _____: Graduated effect achieved by cutting the hair with elevation or over direction; the hair is cut at higher elevations, usually 90 degrees or above, which removes weight
11. _____: These tools are great for removing excess bulk and for blending one length with another
12. _____: Combing a section away from its natural falling position, rather than straight out from the head, toward a guideline; used to create increasing lengths in the interior or perimeter
13. _____: Guideline that does not move
14. _____: Line dividing the hair at the scalp, separating one section of hair from another, creating subsections
15. _____: Haircutting technique designed to remove excess bulk without shortening the length
16. _____: Outer line of a hairstyle
17. _____: To divide the hair by parting into uniform working areas for control
18. _____: Guideline that moves as the haircutting progresses, used often when creating layers or graduation
19. _____: Visual line in the haircut where the ends of the hair band together
