Scenario: You have been awarded a four-year scholarship. You must actively be pursuing a degree in the field of education.

Directions: Individually, you will research four colleges or universities of your choice that provides an education-related program of study and/or certification. If you are interested in Texas colleges/universities, you may use of Compare College Texas at <http://comparecollegetx.com/find-colleges/>. Compare College Texas is an interactive, mobile-friendly web tool designed to help users learn more about Texas public universities and community colleges. To compare colleges, you must first select the button for two or four year schools, and then use the sliding bars to narrow your choices or search for a college or university by name. To simply view an institutional profile, enter an institution name in the search box.

You also have the option of researching out-of-state colleges and universities.

You will use this information to create a quadarama during Independent Practice. You will visually display the information you collected on each college/university on the quadarama. Be prepared to share and present your quadaramas with the class.

On your own paper, include the following information for **EACH** college or university you research:

- Name of college/university
- Location
- Application process
- Campus life; education-based clubs or organizations
- Basic academic courses required in the College of Education
- EDUCATION-RELATED certification programs offered at the college
- EDUCATION-RELATED degree plans offered at the college
- EDUCATION internship/externship opportunities offered
- Five interesting facts about the College of Education
