Infant	Emotional and physical	 Emotional Help develop feelings of security and ease infant's frustrations by providing favorite toys. Show pleasure in repetitive play (clapping hands and showing genuine pleasure) Physical Encourage use of both hands. Help infant develop hand coordination by playing banging games with blocks, balls and stacking toys. 	Sensory (hearing)	 Face the child when speaking to him or her. Introduce sign language to the child 	As young children become more interested in TV, the best option for listening is a personal listening system. These systems allow a child to listen to the TV at a comfortable listening level without disturbing others in the room.
