1. How many entries can there be per chapter?

10

2. What kind of event is this?

- a. Individual
- b. Team
- c. Both a and b

3. What is the main objective of this competition?

To assist TAFE members in compiling a dynamic record of their qualifications, experiences and professional growth.

4. True or False. Members will prepare a portfolio in hard copy AND an electronic format.

Members will prepare a portfolio in hard copy OR electronic format.

5. True or False. Members will give an oral presentation that provides an overview of the sections, summarizing the student’s skills and experiences.

6. True or False. Up to five members may work each portfolio. Preparation and presentation must be done solely by the members.

One student per portfolio. Preparation and presentation must be done solely by the contestant.

7. True or False. Portfolios submitted at the regional competition must be 95% complete and should have placeholders (labeled pages or designated spaces) with a description of the information or artifact to be added, and when it will be added.

Portfolios submitted at the regional competition must be 75% complete and should have placeholders (labeled pages or designated spaces) with a description of the information or artifact to be added, and when it will be added.

8. True or False. Students presenting an electronic portfolio must provide their own laptop to present the portfolio.

9. Contestants will be given up to five minutes to present their portfolio. At the end of five minutes, contestants will be stopped
