





Think-Ink-Pair-Share: Work Ethics and Confidentiality

Pair 	Turn to face your partner and work together to share your ideas, discuss your responses, clarify ideas and challenge your responses.	Partner #1	Partner #2
Share 	As a pair, share your ideas with another pair or in a large group. It is important to share your partner's ideas as well as your own.	Partner #1	Partner #2
