- Oversee record keeping of job-related illness or injury

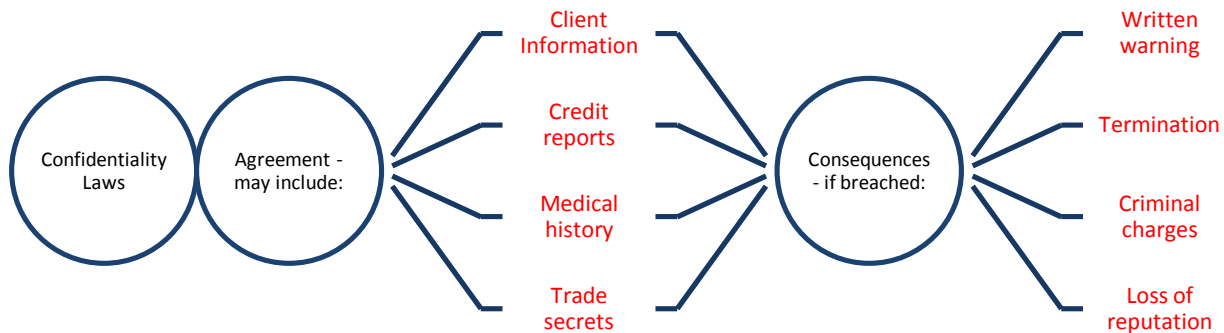
**OSHA** ★
